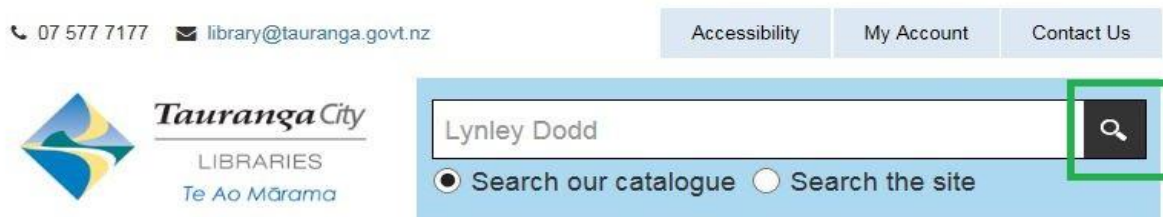


## Local newspaper index

Search for local people, places and events from the Bay of Plenty Times, Te Puke Times and the Katikati Advertiser on our newspaper index, available at <http://library.tauranga.govt.nz>

1. To get started, type your topic into the search bar and click on the magnifying glass icon. We have used the example topic of Lynley Dodd.



2. The results you see at the moment are for books. To change the type of results 'Click for - Newspaper Index'

The results list will show the title of the article in bold type, with the year and then the newspaper title, edition and page number.


